When you download your eBook, you have the choice of downloading it onto your hard drive, or viewing it in conjunction with your Internet Explorer browser. We recommend downloading it onto your hard drive so it is available for future reference.

What exactly is an eBook?

An eBook is a book that arrives to you in an electronic form. Once you download it, if you would like a hard copy, simply press the print button, and it will print a copy right on your printer.

What do I need to read an eBook?

MyMommyBiz uses Adobe Acrobat for all our eBooks, since Acrobat is available cross-platform (both PC and MAC). Many new computers come with the Adobe Acrobat Reader 4.0 or higher already installed. But if you do not have a copy of it yet, you can download it here from Adobe's website.

How do I pay for my eBook?

MyMommyBiz has partnered with Clickbank to offer realtime downloads to all our customers. This means that as soon as your credit card is approved, you can download your eBook! Clickbank accepts all major credit cards for payment.

Is my credit card information secure?

All MyMommyBiz orders are processed through Clickbank's secure server. You can shop knowing that your credit card information is completely safe and secure.

Can I pay with PayPal instead?

Yes, you can pay by PayPal (jen@mymommybiz.com) but please note that MyMommyBiz cannot offer realtime downloads using PayPal. Once your payment is confirmed manually, we will send you your eBook as an email attachment. Please be sure you provide all details for which eBook you are ordering, and that you send the correct amount. If you would like to download as soon as you pay, please use Clickbank instead.

Can I mail a payment?

Yes, you can. Please email for current mailing and payment instructions.

How do I download my eBook?

Once your payment has been confirmed, a screen will provide you with links and the password to open your eBook. You can click right on the link and open it in your browser, but we recommend you choose to "save target as" so that you can keep your eBook on your hard drive for future reference.

How long do eBooks take to download?

Even on the slowest dial-up (modem) connection, it will take less than a minute to download your entire eBook to your hard drive.

She Doesn't Really Work, She Just Works At Home: Legitimizing Your Home Business to Others

When you work at home, too many people think you are free all day to run errands, car pool, babysit, or do many other things that you just do not have time to do.

The problem is that many people just do not see working at home as a legitimate business the way they would view a lawyer or a teacher. After all, you can set your own hours, so why can't you be available to pick up their little Johnny from school, drop him off and baseball practice, then deliver him home an hour later?

But how can you make people see that your business is just that - a business.

First and foremost, get call display. While you don't want to miss any calls from clients, you really don't want to spend an hour on the phone with your best friend as she dissects her latest date, not unless you are an incredible multi-tasker.

Call display will help you weed out those annoying "oh, I'm sure she can do this" calls. Some phone companies even offer the option of multiple voice messages - you can have one that conveys the fact that you are working, and that you are a true business.

Something like "Hi, you have reached Carolyn of XYZ Desktop Publishing. I may be with a client right now and am unable to take your call. Please leave a message and I will return your phone call as soon as possible. Thank you."

When someone does call you and asks you to do something "right now" but it is not convenient for you, consider offering an alternative.

"I'm sorry, Cheryl, but I have a deadline and will be unable to leave the office all day. I am free next Tuesday if you would like me to do it for you then."

Or you can set a schedule that you let others know. Whether you work every morning, or you work all day three days a week, you can offer alternatives to those who want you to do something for them.

If you let people know that you have set hours, and that you aren't available at the drop of the hat (except for emergencies, of course), you will be able show that your business is a true business, even if it is based in your home, and not in an outside office.
